SETTING THE COURSE: GENERATIONS OF FAITH

In January 2014, the Diocese of Brooklyn's Catholic Foundation for Brooklyn and Queens began an extensive planning study which included consultations with pastors, lay leaders and parishioners. AS OF 2017,

In partnership with the School of Evangelization, Catholic Foundation launched the *Catholic Youth Ministry Initiative* in 2011. With the funding from the *Generations of Faith* campaign, the program has expanded dramatically—from 7 parishes to 79 and plays a critical role in deepening the faith of our youth and ensuring the future of our parish communities in Brooklyn and Queens.



- PROMOTE A CALL TO THE PRIESTHOOD AND RELIGIOUS LIFE through a greater exposure to the work of the Church.





SETTING THE COURSE: GRANT PROGRAM SUPPORTED BY CORE EIGHT ENDOWM 1ENT EUNDS

Supported by eight core endowments, created as a result of the 1998 Alive in Hope campaign, Catholic Foundation for Brooklyn and Queens awards grants to organizations that support the ministries of the Church in Brooklyn and Queens and operate in mission-based areas such as senior citizen services, immigration, continuing education for clergy, lay leadership, vocations, evangelization and religious education, care for elderly priests and Catholic education.

Endowment funds managed by a team of professional investment advisers and are invested in socially and morally responsible funds that are aligned with the tenets of Roman Catholic doctrine. The Finance Committee or the Board of Directors oversees the investments. In 2016, Catholic Foundation committed \$1,642,000 to support these critical initiatives.



SETTING THE COURSE: DONOR ENDOWMENT FUNDS

WHAT IS A DONOR ENDOWMENT FUND?

At Catholic Foundation, we work with individuals to create giving plans that best serve both their charitable interests and their personal and financial circumstances. An *Endowment Fund* provides an annual source of funding to a Catholic organization in Brooklyn and Queens of the donor's choice. This fund is designed to function in perpetuity, making it possible to leave a lasting gift to a church or a particular ministry to continue the work of Christ among us. Once established, anyone can make additional contributions to the fund at any dollar amount.

WHO CAN BENEFIT FROM A DONOR ENDOWMENT FUND?

- Donor Endowments are used to provide critical financial support for programs that address social, economic, educational and spiritual needs throughout the Diocese of Brooklyn.
- Donor Endowment Funds allow the donor to restrict funds to any Catholic organization or leave unrestricted to serve the greatest good.
- An immediate gift of \$10,000 or more, in the form of cash, securities, life insurance or real estate, allows you to create an endowment fund quickly and easily.
- The principal remains undisturbed, and earnings are allocated annually to support the specified entity.
- Donors have the ability to leave a legacy by funding an endowment with an estate gift or designation in a will.
- Avoid capital gains taxes on long-term, highly appreciated assets.
- Gifts to a donor endowment fund may reduce income taxes.
- The Foundation's assets are invested in socially and morally responsible funds that are not in conflict with the tenets of Roman Catholic doctrine.

The Kevin Kearney Scholarship Fund was started in 2015 by John Edwards, longtime friend of Kevin Kearney who passed away in 2015 after battling pancreatic cancer. Mr. Kearney, a resident of Rockaway Beach was an active member and generous benefactor of the Diocese of Brooklyn, participating through the National Association of Diocesan Attorneys, the Knights of the Holy Sepulcher, Catholic Charities, The Emerald Society, Futures in Education and the Rockaway Gliders.



Mr. Edwards and Mr. Kearney grew up together and graduated from Nazareth High School. Mr. Edwards said, "We used to run together at 5am and Kevin would spend time sharing news from the church. Catholic education was very

important to Kevin." Mr. Kearney's involvement in the diocese and specifically in *Futures in Education*, which provides scholarships for Catholic school to children in need, was the inspiration for Mr. Edwards to start the *Kevin Kearney Scholarship Fund*.

When Mr. Edwards first decided that he wanted to continue the legacy of Kevin Kearney's generosity, he was not quite sure how to go about it. Turning to Catholic Foundation for advice, the idea of an endowment fund became the obvious choice. Designed to function in perpetuity *The Kevin Kearney Scholarship Fund* will continue to fund its given cause for generations to come. Now *The Kevin Kearney Scholarship Fund* provides two children in need with a scholarship of \$2,500 allowing them to attend Catholic school in the neighborhood every year. Through this fund, Kevin Kearney's generosity and spirit will enable future generations of children to receive the essential foundation of a Catholic education.
