# Generations IMPACT 2018 | PROMISES KEPT

FOR OVER 150 YEARS, the Diocese of Brooklyn has embraced and celebrated the diversity of its communities, families, and faithful. Generations of Catholics have been raised in our tight-knit neighborhoods, celebrating their Catholic faith at our many parishes, and building our church for the future. We have been richly blessed. With those blessings comes the responsibility to share with future generations all that we have received. Generations of Faith, the capital campaign for the Diocese of Brooklyn and Catholic Foundation for Brooklyn and Queens, launched in April 2015 with the goal of \$80 million. We raised \$128 million in pledges and have now surpassed our original \$80 million in collections to date!

Your support of this campaign, which means your continued payment of your pledge, is vital to fulfill the promise we have made to our retired priests, our parishes and our youth who are the future of the Church.

### **IMPACT OF GENERATIONS OF FAITH:**



**Youth Evangelization – \$6.9 million** | Through a comprehensive youth ministry approach, the initiative provides on-site support to parishes through funding salaries of youth ministers, and grants for ongoing resources and professional development. With an investment of \$10 million over the course of Generations of Faith, the program can expand to most parishes across the Diocese by 2021.



Parish Priorities – \$24.3 million | We are blessed with beautiful churches, where the Eucharist is celebrated daily. Embracing our mission to grow ever more perfectly into a community of praise, worship, and witness, Generations of Faith recognizes the central role of parishes in the day-to-day life of the Church. The campaign will allocate the largest portion of the campaign goal - \$40 million directly for parish needs.



Care for Our Priests – \$19.4 million | The Diocese fulfills the Bishop's promise to his senior priests through the St. John Vianney Fund and the Good Shepherd Fund. These two charitable trusts offer financial assistance for the medical and housing expenses of our sick and elderly priests - providing a comfortable and healthy life through their senior years. The campaign will allocate \$30 million to the St. John Vianney and Good Shepherd Fund, to ensure that our current and future senior priests receive adequate care during their senior years.



**CARING FOR THOSE WHO DEDICATED THEIR LIVES** TO THE **CHURCH:** Ensuring quality of life in retirement and beyond

We have all benefited from the generosity of our priests, many of whom stay active in

a local parish long after retirement. However, even the most tireless of servants needs an opportunity to rest from his labor. Funds from Generations of Faith help to assure they receive the care and support they need.



Our groundbreaking Catholic Youth Ministry Initiative, organized in partnership with the Secretariat for Evangelization and Catechesis, remains strong, working with parishes throughout Brooklyn and Queens to ensure that our youth are the next generation of engaged Catholics.

Our Churches are the center of our faith, the physical space that supports our spiritual growth and vital ministries. Generations of Faith funds a wide array of capital projects that are underway across our Diocese, including critical restorations, renovations, and upgrades.

And lastly, our promises to our retired priests who have faithfully served our Catholic communities are being fulfilled. Our sick and elderly priests, through pension funds known as the St. John Vianney Fund and the Good Shepherd Fund, receive financial assistance for such vital services as medical, housing and funeral arrangements. Through Generations of Faith, the parishioners expressed appreciation for our retired priests' many years of service.

### **VISITATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**

98 Richards St, Brooklyn, NY 11231

Goal \$140,000 - Pledged \$379,677 - Collected \$126,094





Funds from Generations of Faith brought hope and an assurance that a faith community with a viable and growing future will exist for the last Roman Catholic Church in the Red Hook region. Parishioners and friends were motivated to participate in the campaign with the firm belief that the mission of Visitation is a call from God. Raising the faith of a people called together for one mission created a spiritual atmosphere - parishioners were ready to give and to serve. Funds will be used for the much-needed painting, flooring and refurbishing of the church and allow Visitation the ability to host events and to launch projects that will continue to promote evangelization in the area.

**OUR LADY OF PEACE** | 522 Carroll St, Brooklyn, NY 11215 Goal \$90,000 - Pledged \$141,040 - Collected \$99,023



Our Lady of Peace needed to install a ramp for the elderly and people with special needs so they could have access to the Church. Funds from Generations of

Faith helped make this a reality.

Your generosity also allowed for the construction of a new bathroom with handicap accessibility.

### ST. NICHOLAS OF TOLENTINE

Space for a much-needed playground, for a successful flea market, and numerous other Church-related activities, became a reality when Generations of Faith funds were used to renovate and pave a huge parking lot. In addition, a new LED sign has been installed at the corner of the parking lot to display announcements and the Mass schedule an important way for St. Nick's to communicate to the community.

A much-needed revamp of the Church's sound system – an ongoing project – also began. In 2019, St. Nick's hopes to be able

to focus on an upgrade to the communication system, the installation of handicap access facilities from the parking lot entrance, and the improvement of security measures with cameras at strategic places inside and outside the Church.


### ST. ANDREW AVELLINO PARISH

St. Andrew Avellino has been able to completely replace the HVAC system in the Church as well as install a new HVAC system in the Academy Cafeteria, which is used by all parishioners and organizations of the parish

The Catholic Youth Ministry Initiative has helped bring many youth programs to the parish. The group is made up of students from the confirmation classes and the local high schools. Activities include small group discussions on topics of faith or morality, and social nights celebrating certain holidays. The youth host family movie nights and monthly visits to

the residents of Sts. Joachim and Ann Nursing home. Youth also involve themselves by assisting at parish events and at Masses as altar servers, ushers, and junior lectors. The youth of St. Brendan hope to grow in their friendship with Jesus and His Church.

Saint Rose of Lima's youth group reflects the culturally and ethnically diverse young community of Rockaway Beach. Since beginning the Catholic Youth Ministry Initiative in 2016, Saint Rose of Lima youth have participated in retreats, prayer and worship experiences, service projects, youth leadership development, and faith study and sharing.

By fully and actively participating in the life of the parish the youth are empowered to share their unique gifts with the wider community by ministering at the monthly Youth Mass, leading an annual fund-raiser, and serving the wider Rockaway community. Through support, friendships, and mutual respect the youth grow closer to Jesus and His Church.

### **ST. BARTHOLOMEW** | 43-22 Ithaca St, Elmhurst, NY 11373



At St. Bartholomew Parish in Elmhurst, two youth ministry programs have been established. Edge serves youth from 5th to 8th grade, and Fuse serves high school youth. At a Fuse or Edge night, youth will have the opportunity to socialize and meet new people, play games, praise and worship through

songs, engage in conversation about faith, and listen to talks in a safe environment. Throughout the week the youth also have the opportunity to come and play sports at open gym, do their homework and have access to help at study club, and grow in scriptural knowledge at a priest-led bible study. Throughout the year the groups participate in Diocesan events.

### **BLESSED VIRGIN MARY HELP OF CHRISTIANS**

The Catholic Youth Ministry Initiative at Blessed Virgin Mary Help of Christians in Woodside is rooted in leading teens closer to Christ through prayer, worship, and community. Lauren Gentry, Pastor Fr. O'Connor and Core Team and Peer Leaders, all work as vessels of the Holy Spirit to walk

with the teens in their faith and lead them to a deeper encounter of the immense love God has for them. This is accomplished through weekly Youth Nights, young men's and women's groups called Warriors and Daughters of the King, retreats, Bible studies, talking with the teens and their families, and everything in between.
