For over 150 years, the Diocese of Brooklyn has embraced and celebrated the diversity of its communities, families and faithful. Generations of Catholics have been raised in our tight-knit neighborhoods, celebrating their Catholic faith at our many parishes, and building our church for the future. We have been richly blessed. With those blessings comes the responsibility to share with future generations all that we have received. Due to the efforts, enthusiasm, and dedication of donors across Brooklyn and Queens, the Diocesan-wide Generations of Faith capital campaign saw sustained success in 2018 as it surpassed its original \$80 million goal.

YOUR GENEROSITY AT WORK

Payments on Generations of Faith pledges are directed back to parishes for improvements, renovations and restorations, as one of the campaign's primary case components. Many projects have been completed, but many

more remain in progress in the 130 parishes where work has begun.

ST. ANDREW AVELLINO PARISH

35-60 158th Street Flushing, NY 11358

Goal \$1,000,000 • Pledged \$1,426,302 • Collected \$1,090,157

St. Andrew Avellino has been able to completely replace the HVAC system in the Church as well as install a new HVAC system in the Academy Cafeteria, which is used by all parishioners and organizations of the parish. Another big project that is just beginning is the restoration of the Church's original 1940 Casavant organ.



OUR LADY of PEACE

522 Carroll Street, Brooklyn, NY 11215

Goal \$90,000 • Pledged \$140,540 Collected \$91,340

Our Lady of Peace needed to install a ramp for the elderly and people with special needs so they could have access to the Church. Funds from Generations of Faith helped make this a reality.

Goal \$485,000 Pledged \$518,303 Collected \$320,954

Renovations made with Generations of Faith funds.







VISITATION of the BLESSED VIRGIN MARY 98 Richards Street, Brooklyn, NY 11231

Goal \$140,000 • Pledged \$377,602 • Collected \$152,368

Funds from Generations of Faith brought hope and an assurance that a faith community with a viable and growing future will exist for the last Roman Catholic Church in the Red Hook neighborhood of Brooklyn. Parishioners and friends were motivated to participate in the campaign with the firm belief that the mission of Visitation is a call from God. Raising the faith of a people called together for one mission created a spiritual atmosphere – parishioners were ready to

give and to serve. Funds will be used for the muchneeded painting, flooring and refurbishing of the church and allow Visitation the ability to host events and to launch projects that will continue to promote evangelization in the area.

Organized in partnership with the Secretariat for Evangelization and Catechesis, our groundbreaking Catholic Youth Ministry Initiative remains strong! Thanks to funding from Generations of Faith, the Initiative has grown to 90 parishes in Brooklyn and Queens. This extraordinary program plays a critical role in deepening the faith of our youth and ensuring the future of our parish communities. Here are just a few examples of youth programs that are flourishing across the Diocese.





Saint Rose of Lima

St. Bartholomew

SAINT ROSE of LIMA | Rockaway Beach

Saint Rose of Lima's youth group reflects the culturally and ethnically diverse young community of Rockaway Beach. Since beginning the Catholic Youth Ministry Initiative in 2016, Saint Rose of Lima youth have participated in retreats, prayer and worship experiences, service projects, youth leadership development, and faith study and sharing. By fully and actively participating in the life of the parish the youth are empowered to share their unique gifts with the wider community by ministering at the monthly Youth Mass, leading an annual fundraiser, and serving the wider Rockaway community. Through support, friendships, and mutual respect the youth grow closer to Jesus and His Church.

ST. BARTHOLOMEW | Elmhurst

At St. Bartholomew Parish in Elmhurst, two youth ministry programs have been established. Edge serves youth from 5th to 8th grade, and Fuse serves high school youth. At a Fuse or Edge night, youth will have the opportunity to socialize and meet new people, play games, praise and worship through songs, engage in conversation about faith, and listen to talks in a safe environment. Throughout the week the youth also have the opportunity to come and play sports at open gym, do their homework and have access to help at study club, and grow in scriptural knowledge at a priest-led bible study. Throughout the year the groups participate in Diocesan events.


ST. MARK/ST. MARGARET MARY & GUARDIAN ANGEL Sheepshead Bay, Manhattan Beach, Brighton Beach

Blessed Virgin Mary Help of Christians

BLESSED VIRGIN MARY HELP OF CHRISTIANS | Woodside

The Catholic Youth Ministry Initiative at Blessed Virgin Mary Help of Christians in Woodside is rooted in leading teens closer to Christ through prayer, worship, and community. Lauren Gentry, Pastor Fr. O'Connor and Core Team and Peer Leaders, all work as vessels of the Holy Spirit to walk with the teens in their faith and lead them to a deeper encounter of the immense love God has for them. This is accomplished through weekly Youth Nights, young men's and women's groups called Warriors and Daughters of the King, retreats, Bible studies, talking with the teens and their families, and everything in between.

ST. CLARE | Rosedale, Queens

"The youth are the future of the church and that future is now," exclaimed the Rev. Andrew L. Struzzieri, aka Fr. Andy of St. Clare Parish in Rosedale Queens, "their

involvement is absolutely essential to the well-being of the church community."

The Catholic Youth Minister Initiative enabled St. Clare to engage their first youth minister in 2016 and kicked off the youth ministry program at the church. Under the guidance of Youth Minister, Peter Damour, the youth program meets on Friday evenings at 7:30 and is active and electric. Peter serves as a liaison for the church congregation and community organizations, increasing communication and participation. Youth in the program are learning together about Christ and are

establishing trust and connection within the church community and the program is thriving.

YOUTH MINISTER SPOTLIGHT: PETER DAMOUR

For the past seven years, Peter Damour has been recognized in his parish as a "humble hero" dedicated to imparting the Catholic faith and inviting youth to understand and apply the power of spiritual teachings in their everyday lives.

Peter's journey began at the tender age of 12 years old when his family moved to Queens. In



service to his new church, St. Clare Parish in Rosedale, Peter joined the choir, youth group and served as an altar server until the age of 18.

In 2016, Fr. Andrew Struzzieri appointed Peter as the first Youth Minister of St. Clare. With the presence of a new Youth Minister, the coordination of many successful youth activities proved to be an exciting development and solidified the importance of youth ministry work as an active and fruitful field.

Peter serves a liaison between the church and community-based organizations with the goal of improving communication, engagement and participation of the church community. As an advocate for the youth, Peter has educated the congregation

about goals, concerns, and the needs of youth in the Parish. He works to further nurture and support his pipeline of diverse youth and partner with them and their adult allies to advocate for their needs and to

champion the youth ministry program. He loves seeing youth take their rightful positions in the Church, serving as ushers, greeters, cantors, or readers with the understanding that they are valued members of the

church community no matter their age.

In 2017, Peter began assisting in the planning of the Kujenga Leadership Conference and serves on the core team for the Diocese of Brooklyn and Queens' Vicariate for Black Catholic Concerns, (VBCC). As a proud Haitian-American, he has similarly assisted the Diocesan Haitian Apostolate with their youth events. Peter is currently enrolled in the City University of New York at Queens College, where he is finishing up his B.A., in hopes of becoming a full-time educator. He is currently an active substitute teacher at several Catholic

Academies within our Diocese in Brooklyn and Queens.



GRANT PROGRAM SUPPORTED BY THE **Core Eight** Endowment Funds

Supported by its eight core endowments, Catholic Foundation for Brooklyn and Queens awards grants to organizations that support the ministries of the Church in Brooklyn and Queens and operate in mission-based areas such as senior citizen services, immigration, continuing education for clergy, lay leadership, vocations, evangelization and religious education, care for elderly priests and Catholic education. In 2018, Catholic Foundation for Brooklyn and Queens formed a new Grant Committee to focus on supporting programs directly benefiting local communities within the Diocese of Brooklyn's parishes and academies. Last year, Catholic Foundation awarded nearly \$2 million in grants to fund over 50 critical projects and programs.

CATHOLIC EDUCATION

The Archbishop Bryan J. McEntegart Fund offers matching funds and program support for Catholic schools and academies in areas including after-school programs and the arts.

In 2018 the fund awarded \$505,000 in grants.



EVANGELIZATION AND RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

The Bishop John Loughlin Fund assists and enhances religious education and evangelization programs throughout the Diocese.

In 2018 the fund awarded \$307,000 in grants.



VOCATIONS

The Bishop Charles E. McDonnell Fund provides funding for proactive discernment programs that promote priestly vocations to qualified young men.

In 2018 the fund awarded \$114,000 in grants.



SENIOR CITIZEN SERVICES

The Bishop Francis J. Mugavero Fund supplies resources for senior citizen services along with elderly housing needs. **In 2018 the fund awarded \$226,000 in grants.**



LAY LEADERSHIP FOUNDATION

The Saint John Paul II Fund supports lay leadership formation and training programs and related initiatives through scholarships and program support.

In 2018 the fund awarded \$232,000 in grants.



IMMIGRATION

The Bishop Thomas V. Daily Fund supports programs and activities related to the ministry of migration in the Diocese. In 2018 the fund awarded \$187,246 in grants.



CARE FOR ELDERLY PRIESTS

The Archbishop Thomas E. Molloy Fund delivers funding for assistance and care of elderly priests as well as those with daily living assistance needs.





CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR CLERGY

The St. Charles Borromeo Fund provides scholarship and program support for the continuing education of our clergy.

In 2018 the fund awarded \$100,000 in grants.





Catholic Charities \$1.1 Million Clyde Walcott

l was unemployed, self-conscious about the way l sounded, people found it

hard to understand me, and I suffered from mental illness. Then I was referred to the Catholic Charities "World of Work" program for employment support. I was supported in resume writing, job searching, interviewing, time and money management, and other job-related issues. Eventually, thanks to the training I received, I became a Peer Advocate and was employed by Catholic Charities in the very same program that had helped me.



Vocations Support \$2.1 Million Seminarian Randy Nguyen

My journey to the priesthood wouldn't be possible if it was not for the

financial support provided by the Annual Catholic Appeal to the vocation office and the seminary programs. Catholic Migration Services

Catholic Migration Services is dedicated to "welcoming the stranger in our midst," by empowering underserved immigrant communities regardless of religion or ethnicity. We provide high quality legal services, education, and advocacy to immigrants to advance equality and social justice in a changing and diverse population. Assisting immigrants with immigration legal services, tenants in Queens with housing legal services, and low-wage workers with employment legal services

In 1971, the Most Reverend Francis J. Mugavero established the Catholic Migration Office in response to the 1969 Papal Instruction Pastoralis Migratorum Cura, written by His Holiness Pope Paul VI on the Pastoral Care of People who Migrate. The office was the first of its kind in the United States and sought to serve the needs of immigrants and refugees living in Brooklyn and Queens.

Since then, the agency has served tens of thousands of immigrants regardless of race, religion, ethnicity, national origin, or immigration status. Those served represent at least 167 countries where individuals collectively speak more than 80 languages. From a small storefront office, Catholic Migration Services has grown to become one of the city's most respected and effective organizations serving immigrants, with offices in Downtown Brooklyn, and Sunnyside, Queens.

Catholic Migration Services is committed to collaborating with and serving the diverse ethnic ministries of our community through pastoral services for immigrants. We preserve the cultural traditions and heritage of our communities by ensuring ongoing fellowship and spiritual growth in the life of the Church.



LEGAL SERVICES

• Provided legal services to more than 4,000 immigrants. Services ranged from consultations to representation in court proceedings.

DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals)

• Helped 133 young immigrants renew DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals), thus preventing their removal and enabling them to work lawfully in the country.

U.S. CITIZENSHIP

• Helped more than 600 immigrants apply to become naturalized U.S citizens.

REUNITING FAMILIES

• Helped 205 immigrants adjust their legal status based on family status, thus reuniting families that had been separated.

TEMPORARY STATUS TPS & ASYLUM

- Helped 51 immigrants obtain or renew their Temporary Protected Status ("TPS"), thus allowing them to remain and work lawfully in the country.
- Helped 31 immigrants obtain asylum or adjust their status based on asylee or refugee status.
- Helped 12 minor-aged immigrants adjust their status based on Special Immigrant Juvenile Status, thus enabling them to get on the path to citizenship.





IN ADDITION, CMS...

- Obtained \$94,000 in fee waivers for various immigration services and submitted an additional \$231,655 in fee waivers completed at naturalization workshops.
- Prevented 24 evictions and delayed the eviction of an additional 5 households, providing them with the time required to obtain alternative housing.
- Obtained repairs, improved housing conditions or otherwise enforced rights to decent habitable housing for 12 households.
- Helped tenants avoid almost \$60,000 in judgments that landlords alleged they owed.
- Obtained over \$131,000 in unpaid wages for 39 low-income immigrant workers;
- Provided **know-your-rights education** to over 4,900 individuals at events held throughout Brooklyn and Queens.



CMS WORKSHOPS HELP NEW YORKERS GET CLOSER TO CITIZENSHIP



Catholic Migration Services partnered with the New Americans Program at the Queens Public Library (QPL) for a free naturalization workshop in Corona. The workshop was open to eligible lawful permanent residents interested in applying for citizenship. Pro bono attorneys, paralegals, and volunteers helped 23 New Yorkers at the Corona Branch complete applications to naturalize.




