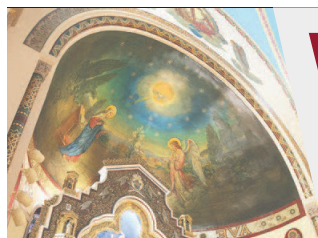

Fifty years ago, Catholic Migration Services was created in response to Pope Saint Paul VI's call to the global Catholic community to support those around the world who seek refuge away from their home countries. Among Catholic Migration Service's many achievements in 2021, we provided immigration legal advice to **1,079** New Yorkers, recovered more than **\$500,000** in unpaid wages for immigrant and low wage workers, aided nearly **1,000** tenants seeking to avoid eviction, and distributed **\$165,000** to **500** families most in need.

Catholic Migration Services is committed to collaborating with and serving the diverse ethnic ministries of our community through pastoral services for immigrants. We preserve the cultural traditions and heritage of our communities by ensuring ongoing fellowship and spiritual growth in the life of the Church.

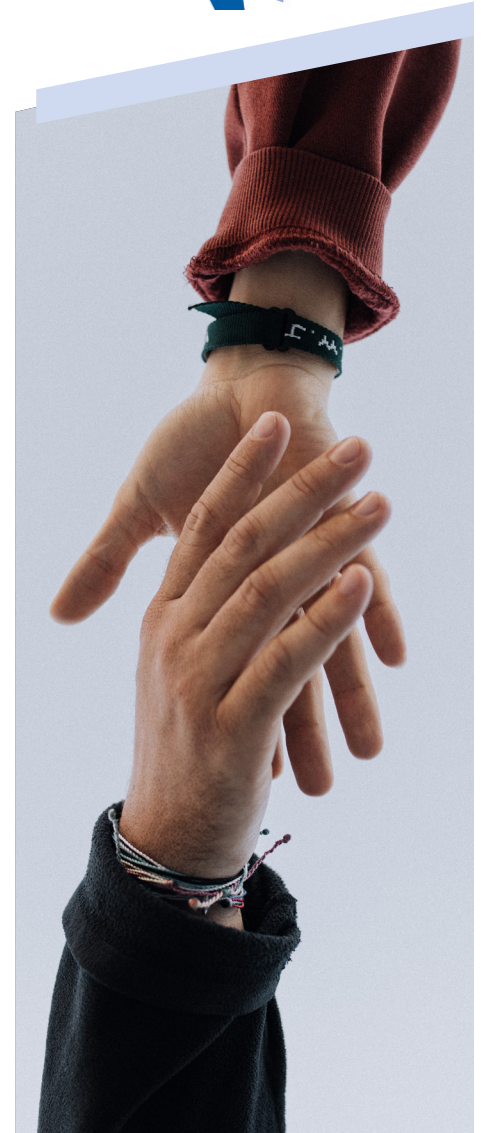
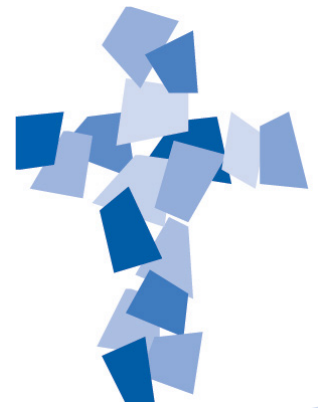

YOUR IMPACT

When Catholic Migration Services first met José and his family, his 18-year-old daughter, Jessica, had joined the Marine Corps after graduating from high school.

As a U.S. citizen serving her country abroad, Jessica was concerned that her parents were at risk of deportation. They had no legal status in the U.S. If her parents were deported, who would care for her two younger sisters, one of whom is epileptic?

Jessica's service in the Marines helped her parents qualify for Parole in Place, a program that legally admitted them to the U.S. and enabled Jessica to petition for them to receive green cards.

In September 2021, Catholic Migration Services successfully filed the necessary petitions and applications.

José is now a legal permanent resident. His wife's application is still being processed and we are waiting for it to be approved. Jessica is now planning to spend more time at home with her family.

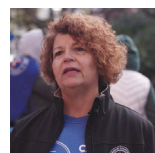

With the support of their building's tenant association, which was organized by the Tenant Advocacy Program of Catholic Migration Services, and in collaboration with a partner legal service provider, Lizbeth and Antonio were able to convince their landlord to renew their lease in their own names. Today Lizbeth and Antonio remain active members of the tenant association.

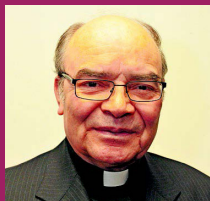

We're very excited to be hosting food distribution pop-ups across communities in Brooklyn and Queens serving a range anywhere from 250 to about 500 people, depending on the area. We're not only handing people food, but we're also trying to connect them with really important information and services that our community offers. Catholic Charities provides a COVID information table; we have a parenting table, we have our Community Outreach Services, with limited financial assistance that can help folks, and we also are offering COVID testing.

The generosity of donors and the Annual Catholic Appeal is so crucial to the mission of the agency to the work that we're doing here in the communities. Without those funds and additional grants, we wouldn't be able to serve the thousands of people that we do.

Msgr. Faustino Cordero is a senior priest who was born in Colombia, where he studied at the Seminario International, Bogota and was ordained on October 10th, 1971. He served in the Diocese of Aruca, Colombia, from 1971-1978. After migrating to the United States, Msgr. Cordero served the Diocese of Brooklyn for more than 43 years. He was an assistant pastor at St. Barbara, Bushwick, 1978-1979; Our Lady of Fatima, Jackson Heights, 1979-1981; and St. Rita, Long Island City, 1981-1992. From 1992 until 2011, he was the pastor of St. John the Evangelist-St. Rocco in Sunset Park, Brooklyn. He was incardinated as a priest of the Brooklyn Diocese in 1987 and named a monsignor in 1999. He also served as director of the Hispanic Curia of the Legion of Mary.

Upon retirement, Msgr. Cordero took residence at St.

Finbar, Bath Beach, where he celebrated his 50th Jubilee on October 10th, 2021. Unfortunately, a month later, he became ill with COVID-19 and was hospitalized. Knowing he would need supervised care going forward, his nephew, Fr. Jesus Cuadros, in residence at Holy Family - St. Thomas Aquinas Parish in Brooklyn, helped coordinate his move to the Bishop Mugavero Residence. Msgr. Cordero currently resides there, under the exceptional care of the staff, and where he also participates in the many programs and activities offered to our retired clergy.

Msgr. Cordero is so grateful to the Diocese and to the many donors who contribute to the Annual Catholic Appeal. In the words of his nephew, "My uncle is extremely grateful."

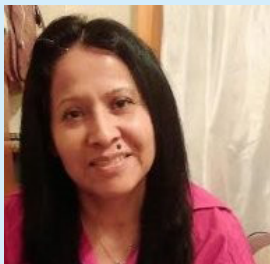
Jamaica Hospital Chaplain

Physical distancing has become necessary to protect against, and prevent the spread of COVID-19. However, distancing has led many into isolation and out of communication. Unable to provide catechesis to children in the same in-person way we were accustomed to, new methods of communication were needed to continue spreading our Christian faith with others.

This year our parish depended on the Annual Catholic Appeal, which funds the Diocesan Office of Faith Formation — their support was essential to continuing our programs. Thanks to donations to the Annual Catholic Appeal this year our parish, and others around the diocese, were able to use online platforms such as FORMED and ZOOM to pass the faith onto the next generation and prepare our children to receive the

sacraments. The transition from in-person to the online teaching was smoothly done thanks to the centralized support we received from the Diocese. We even found that families were more involved in the faith formation of their children using the online platforms and participated along with their children at home as they were instructed in the faith. The Presence, Forgiveness, and Reborn series from FORMED were also used during the Sacramental Preparation Meetings offered to parents to strengthen their faith. The use of this new technology the ability to study in small groups to complete the ten hours of ongoing formation required of them each year. I began to attend Ss. Joachim and Anne School in Queens in the sixth grade. I immediately joined the gospel choir run by Ms. Edwards and I have been singing ever since. Nothing that I've ever been involved in, or went to, has ever been as inclusive and as loving as the Catholic school I attended. This is why when I had my children, I made sure that they attended the same school as I did. Ss. Joachim and Anne is a very family-oriented school. Christ is constantly instilled in the children through prayer, Mass, and in everything that we do; Christ is at the center of it all.

In 2017, I was diagnosed with a degenerative disorder of the cornea, which diminished my eyesight, and forced me to stop working. I wanted my children to still

get the same education I had received in Catholic school, but I could no longer afford it. A Futures in Education scholarship made it possible to keep my children in their Catholic school. Because of the donations to support Catholic school tuition assistance, like those made to the Annual Catholic Appeal, my children were able to continue their Catholic education. I'm forever thankful for the generosity of strangers. I know that my children are going to do amazing things in life and it's all because they attended Catholic school. Thank you.

During the past year, our youth ministers built on the creative approaches they had applied to engaging youth in their parishes as many sought to return to in-person activities. Blending virtual and in-person engagement helped with the transition and kept the youth interested and involved in the life of the parish. Maxine Dinnall: Our Lady of Light Parish

Maxine Dinnall is a wife, mother, sister, aunt, and a friend to her youth group at Our Lady of Light Parish in St. Albans, Queens. In May 2008, Maxine remembers feeling a calling from God toward catechism. That started her on the path to becoming a Youth Minister. She approached Father William Smith, pastor at that time, and together they started a youth group serving the parish. "Thirteen years later and I'm still watching all my youths grow up!" Maxine said. "It's rewarding to see the fruits of our labor."

When the pandemic began, Maxine struggled to keep her youth group engaged with each other and with God. Thanks to the resources and network of youth ministers involved in the Catholic Youth Ministry Initiative (CYMI), Maxine found new and creative ways to connect with young people virtually.

After a long year and a half, Maxine was able to host her first Youth Ministry event in-person this November. Together with Jeffery Hicks, Maxine hosted a Confirmation retreat at Our Lady of Light for those about to receive the sacrament. "Our group was excited to be together again. They all participated in reconciliation and deep meditation in preparation for Confirmation." At the closing prayer circle, the group was encouraged to think about how each individual would like to continue serving the Church.

When asked about why parishioners should continue to support the Catholic Youth Ministry Initiative, Maxine emphasized how important it is for our Catholic youth to have a seat at the table. "Our kids are not just the future; they are the now!" she exclaimed. "The youth of today are deeply curious and smart, and deserve to be empowered through their own expression and faith."

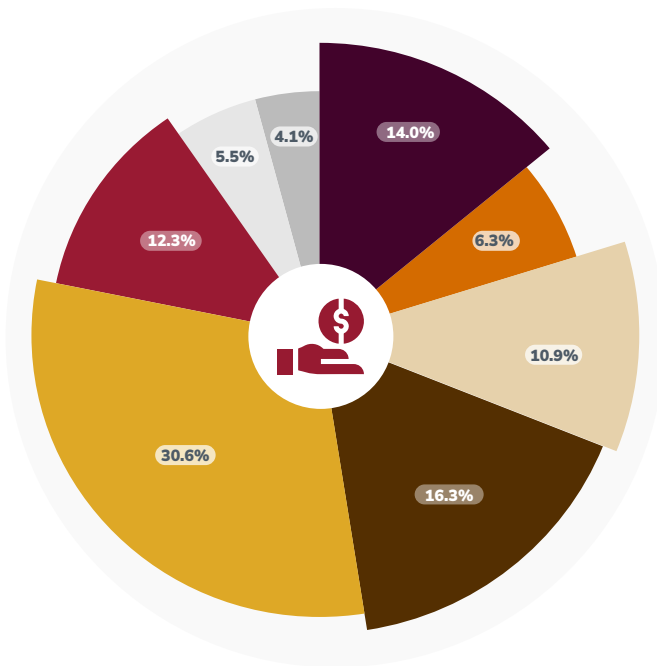

THE REV. ANDREW L. STRUZZIERI MEMORIAL ENDOWMENT FUND

After his passing in 2020, Catholic Foundation established a special fund to honor the memory of Father Andy, a priest of the Diocese of Brooklyn, who dedicated his life to living the Gospel of Jesus Christ by reaching out to those who had both spiritual and financial needs. Whether it was helping someone find a place to live, get a job or just talk about their problems, Father Andrew Struzzieri was more than a sympathetic parish priest — he was a guardian angel.

Father Struzzieri's generosity went global. NYPD Det. Ruben Cespedes remembers being a lonely, homesick 18-year-old in the Army stationed in South Korea. He took a chance and called the rectory of his church, St. Matthew's. Father Struzzieri picked up the phone and the two talked for hours — with the priest offering encouraging words to keep the young man's spirits up.

Our phone calls became a regular thing," Cespedes said. "Fast forward: I came home and we became best friends. There has never been a trial in my life that he didn't know about."

A generous anonymous donor reached out to Catholic Foundation to establish the fund in Father Andy's memory. After the priest's family gave the effort their blessing, the Rev. Andrew L. Struzzieri Memorial Endowment Fund was born.

To preserve the tradition of his charitable work, proceeds from the endowment fund will be used to provide short-term help to struggling members of immigrant and refugee families in Brooklyn and Queens, giving them the chance to pursue their dreams of a better life. Some of the common forms of assistance include:

- Paying for household furnishings for newly arrived immigrants/refugees
- Providing one-time, emergency housing or medical assistance
- Supplying grocery gift cards
- Covering tuition costs for short-term vocational training programs

"Father Andy lived his life by the Gospel, and he inspired so many people. For us to receive a call from this donor, and to hear how his life was shaped by Father Andy is just inspiring, Father Andy showed him the way and it stuck with him so much that he wants to continue the legacy. We feel privileged to help this donor to make this a reality."
