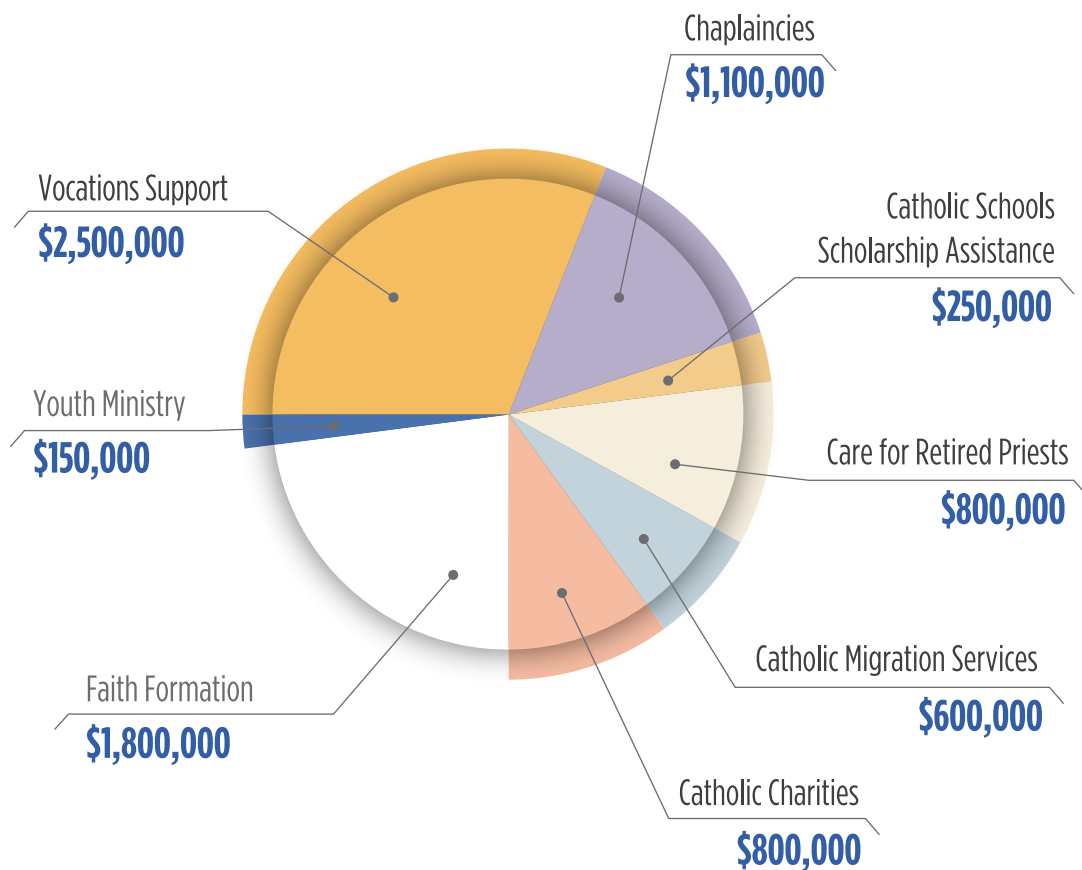

Vocations

In 2023, Bishop Robert Brennan ordained four men to the priesthood at the Co-Cathedral of St. Joseph. The Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) allocates 31% of its \$8 million goal to Vocation Support. This allows the entire diocese to contribute to shaping the Church's future by supporting men in their formation to become priests. Fr. Thimote Cherelus, one of the newly ordained, first felt called as a child in Haiti to the priesthood, which thanks to the support of the ACA has helped take him to his current assignment as a parish priest at St. Matthias in Ridgewood, Queens. Vocation prayers and financial support through the ACA are fostering a promising future for vocations in the Diocese of Brooklyn, with over 40 seminarians currently in formation. This serves as another success story of the ACA positively impacting parish life.



Catholic Youth Ministry Initiative

Nowhere is the impact of the Annual Catholic Appeal greater than in the great work being done by the Youth Ministers active in our parishes across Brooklyn and Queens. One such youth minister who is funded by your support to the Annual Catholic Appeal is Sachara Valmé of St. Clare Parish in Queens. The youth Sachara work with at St. Clare Parish are longing to learn more about their faith and their role in the Church. As the Youth Minister, she is engaged with the youth in many roles like teaching workshops, counseling, and even preparing some for job interviews. She encourages the youth to participate in service projects, attend events around the diocese, plan fundraising initiatives and organize special programs. Equally she believes she is learning from the young people while she is guiding them. "They challenge me to learn, study, grow and take my role as a leader in the Church more seriously...and I love it!"



FAMILY STEWARDSHIP SPOTLIGHT

Dr. Marina Brown of St. Martin de Porres Parish in Brooklyn and her family are great examples of what it means to be stewards. The Annual Catholic Appeal has provided them the opportunity to give back to God for the blessings in their lives. Dr. Brown has also passed down a family tradition of tithing.

Dr. Brown, influenced by her grandmother's example and her parents' teachings, views tithing as a means of expressing gratitude and supporting the Church financially, as well as through time and talent. This tradition extends to her six children and grandchildren, all actively involved in church activities. Dr. Brown emphasizes the importance of being a model of faith in challenging times and acknowledges the Annual Catholic Appeal for enabling her family to serve and support their Church with faith, hope, and charity. The multi-generational commitment to stewardship and tithing reflects a deep faith and a desire to continue the legacy for future generations.



Annual Catholic Appeal PARISH PROJECT SPOTLIGHT

Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish in Jamaica, Queens, faces the challenge of limited building space to accommodate essential programs to strengthen faith and empower the youth. To address this issue, Father Victor Bolaños, the parish's pastor, renovated a former convent building adjacent to the church into a usable community and meeting space. Lacking sufficient funds, he strategically added the cost of renovations to the Annual Catholic Appeal goal over several years. By incorporating a parish project into the ACA, the Presentation of the BVM Parish exceeded its 2023 ACA goal with a \$74,913 received amount and raised over \$18,400 in extra funding for the building renovation. Father Bolaños and the ACA team express gratitude for the community's response, emphasizing the initiative's success in leveraging over-goal funds to support local parish projects and foster growth within the faith community. The model encourages other parishes to identify similar projects, leveraging ACA over-goal funds to address their specific needs with the support of the Catholic Foundation's administrative assistance at no added cost.



CATHOLIC SCHOOL TUITION ASSISTANCE STORY

Lucas Contreras, a Futures in Education scholarship recipient from Holy Child of Jesus Catholic Academy in Queens, has excelled academically and recently graduated as the top student. Accepted into Regis High School, Lucas attributes his success to the Catholic education he received and the support of dedicated teachers at HCJCA instilling values that led him to community service. Grateful for the financial aid received through Futures in Education supported by the Annual Catholic Appeal, Lucas expresses heartfelt thanks and commits to working hard in high school. He aspires to study law at Georgetown University and is determined to give back, recognizing the transformative impact of his education.



Annual Catholic Appeal PARISH PROJECT & CATHOLIC CHARITIES SPOTLIGHT

In Corona, Queens, at Our Lady of Sorrows Parish, where numerous hardworking families reside at or below the poverty line, the Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) has made a substantial impact. Confronting an escalation in food insecurity since the pandemic, the parish initiated its own program to combat the issue, utilizing available space and volunteers and coordinating food drives. Addressing the growing demand, Father Manuel de Jesus Rodriguez, the Pastor, directed funds exceeding the ACA parish goal toward transforming a small storage facility in the church parking lot into a permanent food pantry. With the success of the ACA, the parish has relocated the current pantry to a more suitable space, enhancing its capacity to serve over 600 families monthly. ACA donations also support Catholic Charities in partnering with the parish to manage the food pantry and soup kitchen, which provides hot meals every week, expanding their reach to assist even more needy people.

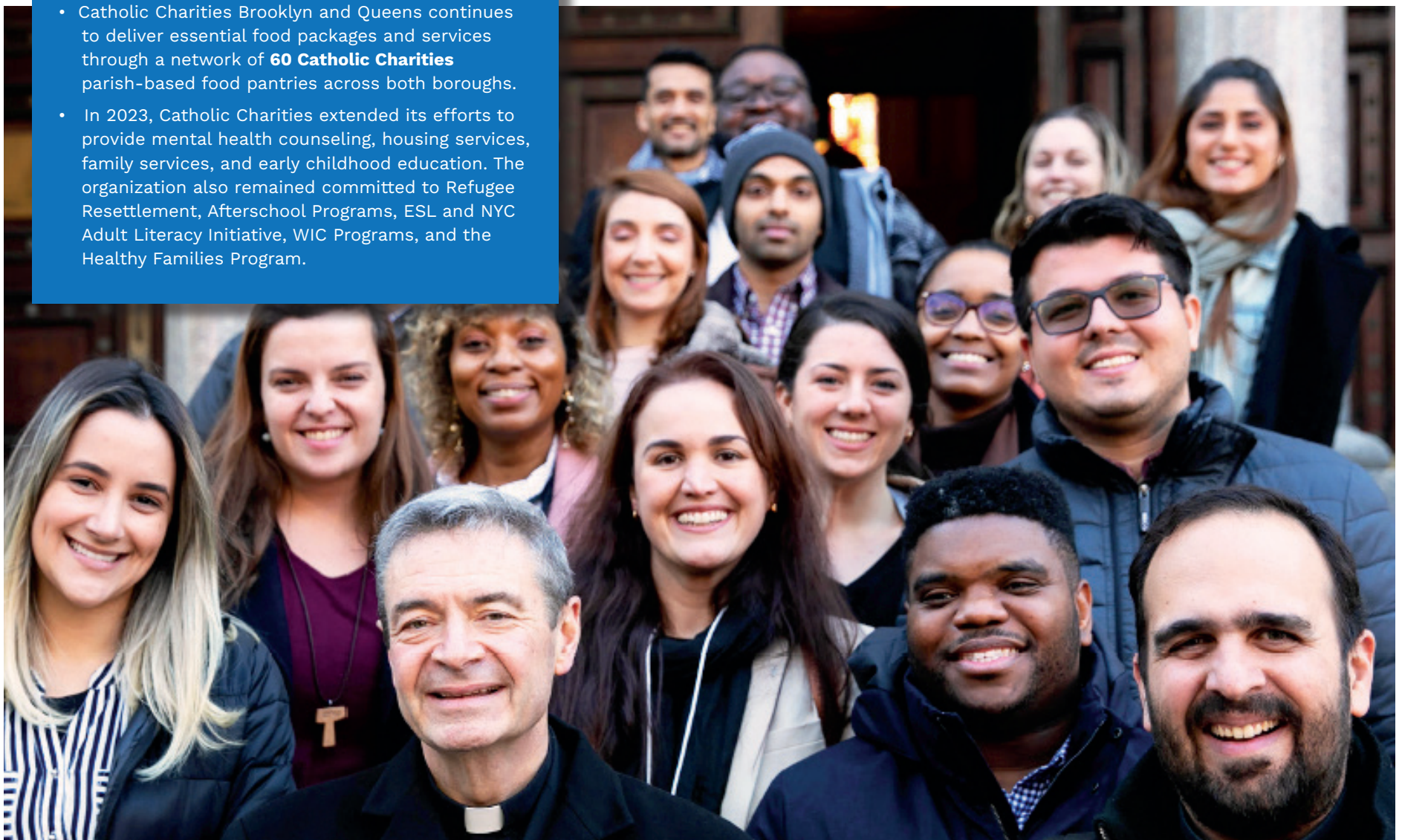
